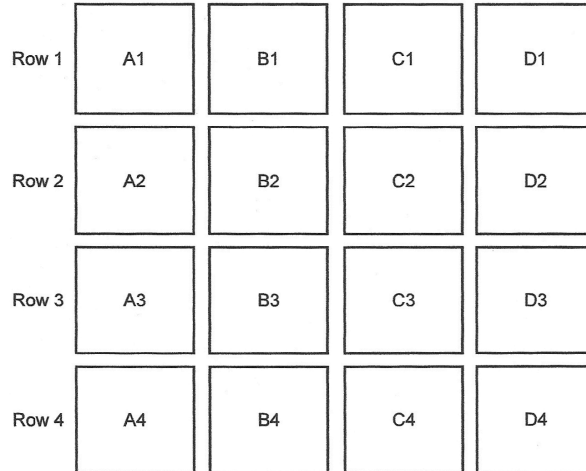


HOW TO CHAIN SEW QUILT BLOCKS

1. Arrange blocks for quilt top

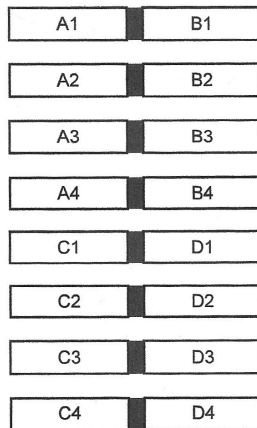


2. Fold blocks together as if seaming the right edge. Place B1 over A1, B2 over A2, etc. Continue with D1 over C1, D2 over D2, etc.

3. Make a stack of the BA blocks, with B1A1 on top: B1A1, B2A2, B3A3, B4A4
Do the same for the DC column.

4. Place the BA stack on top of the DC stack, marking the right seam edge.

5. Move to your sewing machine and chain stitch the entire stack - A1 to B1, A2 to B2, etc. along the right seam edge. (Blue coloring represents sewing lines)



6 . With JUST ONE snip, snip the entire BA chain from the DC chain

7. Chain stitch the two resulting chains - B1 to C1, B2 to C2, etc.

Row 1	A1	B1	C1	D1
Row 2	A2	B2	C2	D2
Row 3	A3	B3	C3	D3
Row 4	A4	B4	C4	D4

Voila, all of your pieces are now together as a quilt top, EXCEPT for the horizontal seams. Therefore...

8. Sew the horizontal rows, Row 1 to Row 2, Row 2 to Row 3, Row 3 to Row 4 and you are finished.

A1	B1	C1	D1
A2	B2	C2	D2
A3	B3	C3	D3
A4	B4	C4	D4
